1. How does one show that there is no <i>prima facie</i> obligation to do <i>x</i> ?
moral collective action problem (MCAP):
The indirect harm principle: We have a moral obligation not to perform an act that causes harm to others indirectly by causing someone to carry out acts that cause harm to others.
The general action principle: I have a prima facie moral obligation not to perform an act when it would be worse for everyone to perform an act of the same kind.
The contractualist principle: I have a moral obligation not to perform an act whenever it violates a general rule that nobody could reasonably reject as a public rule for governing action in society.

Vance's principle: There is a *prima facie* duty to not contributes to a collective action that causes harm when one foresees with near certainty that harm will result from the collective action.
